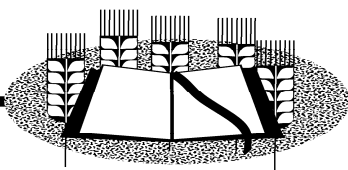

CYO NEWS AND GRATITUDE



As June comes to a close we also saw a completion of the seasons CYO sports activities for our parish community. We are once again greatly impressed by the good work of our CYO Board and volunteers during the past year. In particular we take this long overdue opportunity to acknowledge the long and tireless effort given by Mike Martinez to CYO. We are most grateful for Mike's dedicated and committed leadership to CYO since 2009. Although Mike had been volunteering with CYO for sometime it was in 2009 that he stepped up to lead CYO as Athletic Director for both the Girls and Boys programs. In fact it is largely due to Mike's efforts that we have been able to continue with Boy's Basketball and Girls Volleyball and Basketball since 2009. We have a very small but, dedicated crew that has served as Uniform Coordinator, Registrar and Treasurer along with Mike for quite a few years now. Mike has singlehandedly recruited coaches, assistant coaches, players, scorekeepers, and parent volunteers to keep the programs afloat for the past five years. The years since Mike stepped forward have presented many challenges and without the efforts of Mike, his coaches, and his crew of volunteers the CYO program would have disappeared. The outcome of that most directly would have affected the 200 plus players in CYO each year. In the midst of all this hard work, our CYO boys and girls programs have achieved great results in the volleyball and basketball leagues. This is a large undertaking and Mike succeeded in providing coordinated and efficient work. There are many others who are not named here who added greatly to the efforts and we thank all those who have given of their time and talent to CYO.

This is also a good opportunity to remind those in the community sitting on the sidelines of the need for new leadership in all facets of the CYO program. Although Mike has recruited both a Boy's and Girl's Athletic Director we are still in need of filling a number of Board positions. The rosary will be recited for World Peace after the 8:30 am Mass each Monday in the Church. Please join us.

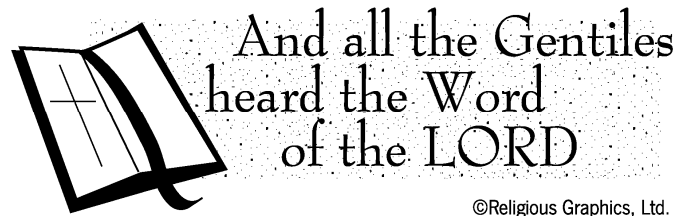
SCRIP NEWS
