

As we prepare to say goodbye to the Augustinians for their 35 years of Pastoral ministry serving the Parish Community of Our Lady of Grace Church and School let us look back in gratitude and thanksgiving. Below is the announcement from **The Catholic Voice, June 16, 1980** announcing the assignment of the Augustinians to Our Lady of Grace as well as the first bulletin announcement from the Augustinians, **July 6, 1980**.

Catholic Voice, June 16, 1980

IN THE DIOCESE:

The new pastor of Our Lady of Grace will be Augustinian Father Vincent J. McGarvey, with associates Fathers William H. Sullivan, John E. Ranallo, and James P. Clifford. They bring a varied background in ministry with Father McGarvey, totally 35 years in parish work on the East Coast and California. He leaves St. Patrick Parish, San Diego.

Father Sullivan returned a few months ago from a four year assignment at the Augustinian headquarters. He previously was engaged in secondary school work. And recently participated in the clinical pastoral education program at St. Mary's Hospital, San Francisco. Father Clifford taught high school and last year was a hospital chaplain at Napa.

Our Lady of Grace Parish Bulletin, July 6, 1980

Dear Brothers and Sister in Christ,

"We are created anew"--this is the theme that shines through the Scriptural readings proclaimed in today's Mass. In one sense, this parish community is today being created anew, as this Castro Valley community is challenged to adjust to a new group of priests assigned to this ministry by the Bishop of the Diocese of Oakland.

For our part, the fact that our Augustinian superiors sent us to this new ministry among you in no way lessens our joy in being in your midst. We are happy to respond to the invitation from the Diocese of Oakland to undertake this ministry. Certainly, each one of us leaves behind another ministry, in another place, with other friends. Today, however, Our Lady of Grace is the only ministry we have, and the only ministry in which we know we can do God's will -- by serving you. And we thank God for this opportunity, to respond to a need in this Diocese and to become, and be, new members of this Catholic Christian community.

And we begin this new ministry with a sense of gratitude, for all that has gone before. The living community of faith that is this parish is the fruit of the labor of so many, lay persons as well as priests, who have worked to create, down the years, the spirit and the physical plant that make Our Lady of Grace what it is today. We thank them -- and you who are among them -- for the traditions and spirit that we have inherited by being the first Augustinians to minister at Our Lady of Grace.

May God bless you and be with us all as He continues to create us anew in the months and years ahead.

GOSPEL FOR THE 13th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, June 28th

MARK 5:21-24, 35B-43

When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a large crowd gathered around him, and he stayed close to the sea. One of the synagogue officials, named Jairus, came forward. Seeing him he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him, saying, "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." He went off with him, and a large crowd followed him and pressed upon him. While he was still speaking, people from the synagogue official's house arrived and said, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." He did not allow anyone to accompany him inside except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep." And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Talitha kum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat.

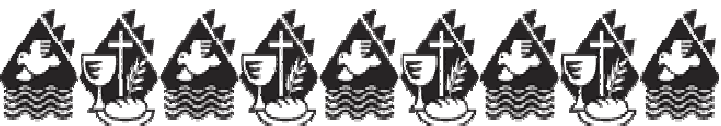
If you would like your envelope number, or if you need any other information in order to set up your online bill pay, please contact the parish office.

FESCO SHUFFLE THANK YOU

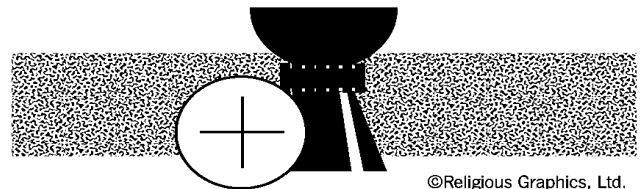
Another FESCO Shuffle is behind us and all those who participated had a wonderful time walking around the marina in San Leandro.
