AN EPIPHANY HOME BLESSING

The Gospel tells us that the magi found Christ "on entering the house." The door to your home is a holy threshold. It is appropriate to bless your door in January – "janua" means "door," and the first month is the door to the new year.

You can bless those who come in and go out by inscribing above the door in chalk: 20+C+M+B+16. Tradition tells us that the letters stand for the names of the magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Scholar Adolph Adam points out that it may also mean "Christus mansionem benedicat" or "May Christ bless this dwelling."

BLESSING CEREMONY

Light a candle. Inscribe door as above in Chalk

A member of the family prays: *May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve Christ in everyone we meet.*

All: Amen.

Together: *Lord God of Heaven and Earth, You revealed Your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. May we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness, and the keeping of Your law. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect Your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

On February 22, 1931, Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ appeared to this simple nun, bringing with Him a wonderful message of Mercy for all mankind. Saint Faustina tells us in her diary under this date:

"In the evening, when I was in my cell, I became aware of the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From the opening of the garment at the breast there came forth two large rays, one red and the other pale. In silence I gazed intently at the Lord; my soul was overwhelmed with fear, but also with great joy. After a while Jesus said to me, 'paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You.'"

Gospel for THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD (January 10th)

Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

The people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."


