From the Pastor

Greetings regular readers of the "Pastor's Column" ... I am taking this space for a week or two!! (Don't tell Fr. Tom!!! - Just kidding!!) It was such a blessing to be able to share and open our home to some of you last week. We understand, and are sad, that we were not able to invite all, it is not a lack of Love, but of Space!) But in the same spirit, of sharing more of our lives with you, I'd like to let you know about an upcoming HISTORIC event. Our Conventual Franciscans have recently combined all our formation programs (the years our students spend in formal studies) into One program, for all of our student friars in the U.S., Canada, and Australia. This helps us provide a better quality formation, and allows our students to have more peers during these formative years, where one often forms relationships that last throughout their lives as friars!

Because of this change, for the FIRST TIME ever, all the provinces of the United States, Canada, and Australia will be sharing in a FIRST PROFESSION of VOWS Ceremony here in Pismo Beach, CA, on July 18-22nd. As our Vocation Director, my job is to help those discerning how to serve God, and considering Religious Life as a possibility, to learn more about our way of life. So I am building a Come and See event for young men, 18-50 years old, to drive with me from Castro Valley, to Pismo Beach as part of a 4 day Come and See event, where we will share more about our Franciscan Life! Can you help me get the word out? In the short time I've been vocation director, I've learned that the best approach is to get as many as possible to PRAY for VOCATIONS, and to be on the lookout, to Invite those who you think would make a good priest or brother, and ASK THEM "HAVE YOU EVER CONSIDERED BEING A PREIST (or Brother/Sister, or Franciscan)." Studies show that most those who've discerned a vocation, have had someone else either get them thinking about it, or get them to act on it, by someone asking THAT QUESTION! And, don't be afraid if they laugh at you!!! My Father first said that to me when I was 19, and I laughed at him..... Don't be afraid to be a prophet! It is part of our Baptismal Call!!!!!! I have put flyers for the event at the entrances to the Church! Please take a few and pass them out!

Also, everyone is invited, to make a "mini-vacation" and come to the event at St. Paul of the Apostle Parish in Pismo Beach (800 Bello St.) on Thursday, July 21, at 11AM! Pismo Beach is a GREAT place to spend a few days! Please Pray for vocations, and hand a flyer to someone!

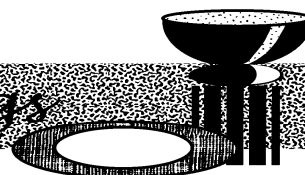
Dear OLG Community,

HOUSING FOR OUR REFUGEE FAMILY**

We still don't know when our refugee "family" will arrive, and sometimes Catholic Charities is not able to give much advance notice. They could arrive in few weeks or not for several months, but when they come, they will need a place to live. Occasionally a refugee family has an extended family member in the area to live with, but often they need housing. As you know, affordable housing in the East Bay is extremely difficult to find. Right now we are just putting out "feelers" to see if anyone in the parish knows of any inexpensive housing possibilities such as a rental property that is vacant or may become vacant, an in-law unit, or a cottage. ALL VICTIMS OF VIOLENCE

GOSPEL FOR FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (JULY 10TH) LUKE 10:25-37

There was a scholar of the law who stood up to test him and said, "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus said to him, "What is written in the law? How do you read it?" He said in reply, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." He replied to him, "You have answered correctly; do this and you will live." But because he wished to justify himself, he said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus replied, "A man fell victim to robbers as he went down from Jerusalem to Jericho. They stripped and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead. A priest happened to be going down that road, but when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side. Likewise a Levite came to the place, and when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side. But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him was moved with compassion at the sight. He approached the victim, poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them. Then he lifted him up on his own animal, took him to an inn, and cared for him. The next day he took out two silver coins and gave them to the innkeeper with the instruction, 'Take care of him. If you spend more than what I have given you, I shall repay you on my way back.' Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbor to the robbers' victim?" He answered, "The one who treated him with mercy." Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."

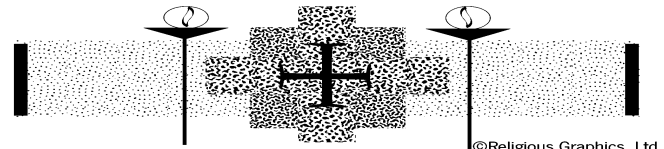

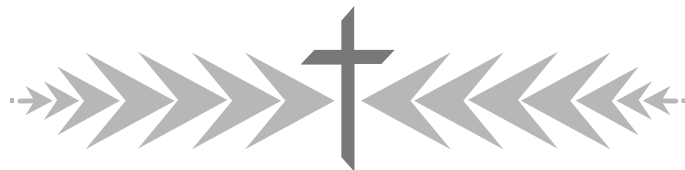
FLOWER REMEMBRANCE FUND
