
**He has risen from the dead!**

*From the Pastor*

For Holy Week I went to go see the movie, A Case for Christ. My sister several years ago read the book and it inspired her to make a deeper commitment to living her faith. In the movie, the resurrection is the central question Lee Strobel, an atheist, was seeking to disprove. In his research to disprove the resurrection of Jesus through Scientific experts. Lee came to the conclusion that there was so much evidence that he had to put his faith in Jesus who rose from the dead.

The Apostle Paul addressed the necessity of the Resurrection of Jesus for our faith to be true in 1 Corinthians 15:13-19: "But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen. And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty. Yes, and we are found false witnesses of God, because we have testified of God that He raised up Christ, whom He did not raise up – if in fact the dead do not rise. For if the dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen. And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins! Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable."

We live in a time of skepticism especially about religious beliefs as illogical, emotionally based, and being myth. Many of your family members may give you reasons for their lack of belief. As Catholics can we respond through many means: Prayer, Apologetics of logical explanations of our beliefs, Scientific evidence to the events of Biblical events and Jesus life, the witness of the Saints, the testimony of Faith alive in our lives, Miracles and Apparitions through out history, ect.

We come to the empty tomb today and hear the testimony of the witnesses in the Scripture. Every time we celebrate Mass we proclaim the Resurrection. He has risen! Each of us can reach him, know Him, and be and touch by him. Through our Baptism we are united to him and we have become sons and daughters of God through Him. For this encounter we must believe in Him and put our faith in Jesus. Jesus is risen and He will be with us always.

He has truly Risen Alleluia!

**Gospel for the Second SUNDAY of EASTER (April 23rd)**
**John 20:1-9**

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Now, Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.

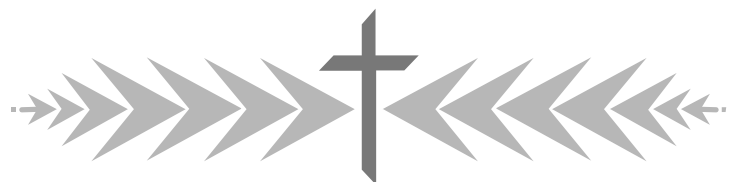
