



Our Lady and the New Evangelization

The Blessed Virgin Mary is the secret to all great evangelizing. While on our own we might participate beautifully in the Lord's work of converting the hearts of some people, the Blessed Virgin has been known to convert entire continents. The story of Our Lady of Guadalupe is a wonderful example of how quickly and easily she brings people to her Son.

Rather than rely on our own efforts to make disciples of Jesus Christ, let us turn ourselves, our ministry, and our parish over to Mary, asking her to do what she does best – quickly and efficaciously convert hearts and bring them into deep intimacy with Jesus.

Here are a few ways to surrender ourselves and our evangelizing mission to Our Lady:

Pray the Rosary

Pray the Rosary for your own continued conversion and holiness. In addition, pray for those whose hearts are far away from God, mentioning them by name in your prayer. Consider praying a Rosary for Evangelization

Consecration to Mary Immaculate

Consecrate yourself, your ministry, and your parish to the Immaculate Heart! This act of surrender will give Our Lady full permission to enter your life and your ministry and infuse it with her own unimaginable fruitfulness. Consider using one of these resources to make an act of total consecration to Jesus through Mary:

O Immaculata, Queen of Heaven and earth, refuge of sinners and our most loving Mother, God has willed to entrust the entire order of mercy to you. I, (name), a repentant sinner, cast myself at your feet, humbly imploring you to take me with all that I am and have, wholly to yourself as your possession and property. Please make of me, of all my powers of soul and body, of my whole life, death and eternity, whatever most pleases you. If it pleases you, use all that I am and have without reserve, wholly to accomplish what was said of you: "She will crush your head," and "You alone have destroyed all heresies in the whole world." Let me be a fit instrument in your immaculate and merciful hands for introducing and increasing your glory to the maximum in all the many strayed and indifferent souls, and thus help extend as far as possible the blessed kingdom of the most Sacred Heart of Jesus. For wherever you enter you obtain the grace of conversion and growth in holiness, since it is through your hands that all graces come to us from the most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Gospel for The Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 30th)

Matthew 13:44-52

“The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it. July 29th -30th is Mission Co-op weekend please join us in welcoming Rev. Nelson Libera who will be speaking on behalf of the Archdiocese of Verapoly in Kerala, India. Rev. Nelson’s visit is in conjunction with our participation in the Annual Mission Cooperative Appeal for the Diocese of Oakland. The Diocese of Verapoly in Kerala, India was one of the first Catholic Dioceses of India, serving over 73,000 Catholic families. They need financial help to support and fund the projects of the mission, specifically in these areas: the education of Seminarians, catechetical formation, housing for the homeless, health care programs, empowering women, harvesting rain water, vocational training, supporting orphanages and nursing homes, and the upkeep of Catholic grade schools and high schools. What Rev. Nelson and the people of Kerala, India offer you in return is their sincere prayers. “Our poor people will remember all of you in their prayers. Jesus says: ‘just as you did it to the least of your brethren, you did it to me’”.

MASS TIMES CHOICE RESULTS

What was clear is that 5PM and 7:30PM want to remain at their current times. The Mass that had the highest percentage for change was the Spanish Mass. The 9:30AM Mass was 49% to remain at the current time or no Preference, at the 11:30AM it was 46% in favor of the current time or had no preference. There were 102 surveys at 5PM, 82 at 7:30, 147 at 9:30, 90 at 11:30, and 89 at 1:30.

Join us every Saturday for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament following the 8:30am Mass, and every Thursday at 7:00pm in the church.



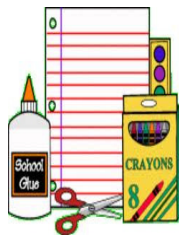

FESCO BACKPACK DRIVE

As you know, every summer FESCO, (Family Emergency Shelter Coalition), sponsors a backpack drive that our church generously supports. This drive supplies the families it serves with school supplies they will need for the upcoming academic year.

If you would like to participate, we are asking you to “adopt” a student. An organization has generously agreed to donate backpacks, so you would just be providing the supplies for the backpack. For the student you “adopt,” we will provide you with a specific list of grade-appropriate supplies and a paper bag in which to put the supplies. After all the supply bags are turned in, we will transfer the supplies to the donated backpacks. **We estimate that all of the needed supplies for a backpack (at “Back to School” discounts) will cost \$30 – \$60 depending on the grade level.**

You can sign up at the entrances to the church after the Masses on the weekends of **July 22 - 23 or July 29 -30. Completed bags will need to be returned to the church or church office on or before Sunday, August 13.** (Church office is closed on weekends.)

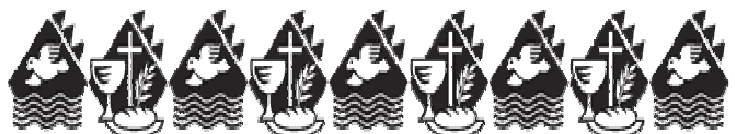
