Evangelization Outreach

Evangelization is about sharing with someone the joy we have in a relationship with Jesus. Our Evangelization outreach this year will be in all our faith formation events. Sacramental preparation and faith formation will be offered in the whole family catechesis model. The whole family will join together to share our faith in Jesus and learn together his love and the truths He revealed to his disciples and the Church.



Gospel for the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (August 13th)

Matthew 14:22-33

Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. Later that night, he was there alone, and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

In honor of this anniversary and the witness of the life and heroic death of St. Maximilian Kolbe we will use his reflections to help us enter into the mysteries of the Rosary. Our Reflection this week is the Joyful mystery of the Annunciation:

"The Joyful Mysteries

The Annunciation--Luke 1:26-38

[Our Lady is] 'Full of grace' because she could not possibly have been deprived of any grace. How beautiful is such fullness of grace, whose abundance flows back unto us in profusion! Or rather, that fullness is a source of grace for us.

'The Lord is with you!' It is true: God is always with her and in such a close, perfect manner! Is she not in some way a part of the Holy Trinity Itself?...And where she goes, she takes along the whole Holy Trinity. How true are the words whereby in the universe everything happens 'in the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit through the Immaculata!' (KW 991)"


