We are excited to introduce you to Jackie Cruz our VBS Director this summer!

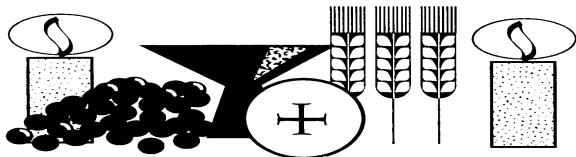

**Gospel for the Fourth Sunday of Easter (April 22nd)**

**John 10:11-18**

Jesus said: "I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. A hired man, who is not a shepherd and whose sheep are not his own, sees a wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away, and the wolf catches and scatters them. This is because he works for pay and has no concern for the sheep. I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd. This is why the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down on my own. I have power to lay it down, and power to take it up again. This command I have received from my Father."

This gives them the peace of mind that they won't be towed and lose not only their shelter but all their possessions. Not an easy life as they try to find places to park where they are safe. Many of the people that we have helped with food this year is through our Wednesday afternoon soup & sandwich meal. Fr. Tom has allowed us to use a room in the parish offices during the winter where we can invite people in for a bowl of homemade soup, sandwiches & dessert. 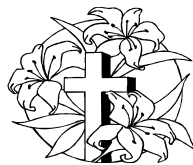
