The Role of a Father in passing on the Faith

Next Sunday is Father's Day. We will honor fathers and their essential role in family and faith. In the Swiss study, when fathers were the spiritual leaders with his wife in the home, 33% of children grew up to regularly practice their faith and 41% practiced irregularly. Just think of the potential we have if we are intentional about our leadership. In that survey, the faithful fathers were just doing what came naturally to them. But knowing what we know, we can approach our role as husbands and fathers with a much more intentional effort to educate and inspire our children. When a Father practices the faith irregularly then only 3% become regular church goers.

By taking the lead on the 3rd Commandment, you will give your kids a lot of reasons to honor the 4th commandment. When they are adults, they will be more equipped to hand down the faith, thereby rebuilding a culture which has largely abandoned the Lord's day. Blessings for Father's Day!

Gospel for The Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time (June 17th)

Mark 4:26-34

Jesus said to the crowds: "This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come." He said, "To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade." With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it. Without parables he did not speak to them, but to his own disciples he explained everything in private.
