



**Be A Disciple**

Our Lady of Grace is has embraced the call of Pope Francis to be Missionary Disciples. Our Model for sharing the faith is more community oriented based on faith events seeking to draw us into the Mystery of God and then to share that experience with the World. In his apostolic exhortation “The Joy of the Gospel” (“Evangelii Gaudium”), Pope Francis invites all the faithful to be “missionary disciples.”

His call, which has captured the hearts and minds of many, prompts us to ask: “What is a missionary disciple?” If we take a closer look at Pope Francis’ words, we realize that they are meant not as a general summons, but as a deeply personal invitation to each one of us. We are each called to live out the gift and meaning of our baptism by our participation in the life of the church, and by our words and actions that witness to the transforming power of the Gospel.

Pope Francis offers his personal invitation when he said in that same exhortation:

“In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the people of God have become missionary disciples (cf. Mt 28:19). ... The new evangelization calls for personal involvement on the part of each of the baptized.

“Every Christian is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization; indeed, anyone who has truly experienced God’s saving love does not need much time or lengthy training to go out and proclaim that love.

“Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus: We no longer say that we are ‘disciples’ and ‘missionaries’ but rather that we are always ‘missionary disciples’” (No. 120).

Missionary discipleship begins with, and grows in, friendship with the person of Jesus Christ.

Once we have truly experienced in a personal way the immense love and mercy of God revealed in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, daily life is no longer the same. It is always God’s love and grace that first transforms us into missionary disciples.

With the grace of our baptism, we carry within us that same love of God that radiates to all around us, particularly to the poor and those who exist on the social and moral margins of society.

To become a missionary disciple, then, is to hear the voice of Jesus calling us to live the new life of faith in him.

We receive this new life of faith at baptism, and the whole Christian life is an unfolding of the initial baptismal gift of faith — faith that is believed, celebrated, lived and deepened through prayer. This first encounter with the love of God is that moment of evangelization, when the seed of the Gospel planted in our lives begins to grow and flourish.

Catechesis is the deepening of this baptismal gift of faith through an ongoing journey of coming to know and be formed in faith.

**FORMED** On Demand is the popular and highly successful service where subscribers can view FORMED subscription content (studies, movies, audio, e-books). It now has over 500,000 registered users, and is used by 3,400 parishes worldwide; we also have over 39 dioceses who have signed deals to use the service, including the diocese of Oakland. FORMED On Demand has been called “*Netflix for Catholics*” as it features thousands carefully curated video/audio programs, e-books, and movies from a wide variety of trusted Catholic sources for a flat, recurring fee.

Another component is a personal cloud library that allows users to assemble their own collection of favorites, which can be streamed or downloaded to any of their mobile devices and played offline. This is currently available with our iOS FORMED app and will soon be available on Android as well.

We will be adding other exciting components in the near future, but as you can see FORMED is becoming a complete ecosystem for top quality digital content for Catholics.



Now type in the parish code M2RBFP. Set up a username- whatever username you’ll remember - and a password and you are all set to explore all FORMED has to offer.
