



Prayer and Penance for the Church

The Pope, Cardinals, and Bishops met last week to discuss how to respond to Clergy Sexual Abuse. Before the meeting it was announced that former Cardinal McCarrick was defrocked and removed from the priesthood for his abuse of the Sacrament of Confession and abuse of children. The Diocese released the names of priests that were credibly accused of sexually abusing children over the last 80 years. The last cases of reported abuse by Diocesan Clergy seems to have been in the 1980's and those who were credibly accused are no longer in ministry. The Body of Christ mourns and is injured by such sin. How do we respond to such evil?

I ask that we pray asking intercession of Our Blessed Mother that Christ may purify the Church. We need the Good News of the Gospel to bring us to Jesus and the Truth. We need the Sacraments to connect us and sustain us in the Love of the Trinity. We need Holy Pastors who love and do not abuse the faithful.

Septuagesima or 70 days before Easter began last weekend. This time until Lent traditionally has been a pre-Lent time of penance, Septuagesima being a time of voluntary fasting in preparation for the obligatory Great Fast of Lent. The theme is the 70 years of the Babylonian exile, the "mortal coil" we must endure as we await the Heavenly Jerusalem. Sobriety and somberness reign liturgically; so we will end Mass with the St. Michael Prayer in the St. Michael Hymnal number 840 and depart in silence. May justice come, those hurt be healed, and may the Church be purified from all evil.

Pilgrimage of the relic of St. Jean Vianney

Gospel for The Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time (March 3rd)

Luke 6:39-45

Jesus told his disciples a parable, "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit? No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher. Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye,' when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye? You hypocrite! Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother's eye. "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit. For every tree is known by its own fruit. For people do not pick figs from thornbushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles. A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks."

Theresa and her adult daughter live in Section 8 housing. Their apartment has mold which is causing some health problems for Theresa. The landlord refuses to improve the situation and has told her to move. Her daughter is bipolar and recently had back surgery. We help them monthly with food and occasionally with utilities. After 5 years they finally found housing that would accept her Section 8 voucher. They will be moving in mid-February and we will help them with their first month's rent. We send them off with our prayers as they leave the area.
