


Fathers Day Message from Fr. Tom

From the Pastor

A rather large and important study conducted by the Swiss government in 1994 and published in 2000 revealed some astonishing facts with regard to the generational transmission of faith and religious values. In short, the study reveals: “It is the religious practice of the father of the family that, above all, determines the future attendance at or absence from church of the children.”

1. If both father and mother attend regularly, 33 percent of their children will end up as regular churchgoers, and 41 percent will end up attending irregularly. Only a quarter of their children will end up not practicing at all.
2. If the father is irregular and mother regular, only 3 percent of the children will subsequently become regulars themselves, while a further 59 percent will become irregulars. Thirty-eight percent will be lost.
3. If the father is non-practicing and mother regular, only 2 percent of children will become regular worshippers, and 37 percent will attend irregularly. Over 60 percent of their children will be lost completely to the church!

What happens if the father is regular but the mother irregular or non-practicing? Amazingly, the percentage of children becoming regular goes up from 33 percent to 38 percent with the irregular mother and up to 44 percent with the non-practicing. This suggests that loyalty to the father’s commitment grows in response to the mother’s laxity or indifference to religion.

In short, if a father does not go to church – no matter how faithful his wife’s devotions – only one child in 50 will become a regular worshipper. If a father does go regularly, regardless of the practice of the mother, between two-thirds and three-quarters of their children will become churchgoers (regular and irregular). One of the reasons suggested for this distinction is that children tend to take their cues about domestic life from Mom while their conceptions of the world outside come from Dad. ***If Dad takes faith in God seriously then the message to their children is that God should be taken seriously.***

I want to thank my Father James and Grandfathers Michael and John Emil who practiced the faith and gave me an example of the importance and value of the faith to help us in life. Our gift to our Fathers this weekend is a medal and prayer card of St. Anthony. Here are 15 characteristics of St. Anthony to help our Fathers to be good holy men.

1. Obedience to God,
2. Purity of heart
3. Passion for the Holy Scriptures
4. Love for the Holy Eucharist and devotion to the Blessed Mother Mary
5. Prayerful
6. Total Humility
7. Disciplined
8. Courageous
9. Love for the poor and sick
10. Passion for learning and teaching
11. Patient
12. A man of integrity
13. Sanctity of life
14. Good servant leader
15. Unbreakable commitment for evangelization

Fathers Day Message from Pope Francis

St. Joseph’s “great mission is to be a guardian,” the pope said.

The saint is a model for all educators, whether they are teachers, catechists, parents, religious or priests, “who are fathers, too, you know!” he said.

Like an educator, St. Joseph guided and accompanied Jesus so he could grow in “wisdom and age and grace,” Pope Francis said. This is the same thing all parents must do, and “it would be a serious mistake to think that a father and a mother can’t do anything to teach their children to grow in God’s grace,” he said.

Even though God was Jesus father, St. Joseph lovingly took on the paternal role and taught the young Jesus various skills, the value of work, reverence for the Lord, and fidelity and obedience to God’s will, the pope said.

He also had to keep his family safe during the difficult period of their exile to Egypt, he said, which makes the saint a special example for refugees and those facing persecution.

The Pope said St. Joseph “knew how to cross the darkness of doubt, the experience of exile and fleeing from home, without ever losing faith in God and his love.”

“Learn from him that only trust in God can turn doubt into certainty, evil into good, total darkness of the night into a radiant dawn,” he said.

The Pope gave his heartfelt greetings to all fathers, ”Best wishes! All the best on your day!”

Children's Liturgy and Tuesday Morning Bible Study will be on summer break and will resume in September, after Labor Day. See you in the fall!


CHILDREN'S GUIDE TO MASS




DID YOU KNOW???
