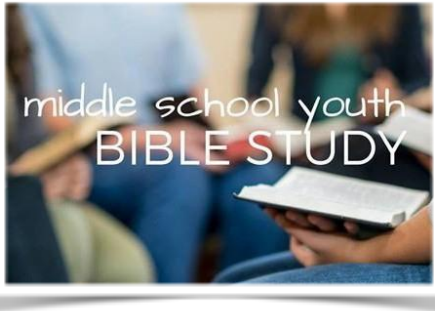

Confirmation

Sundays 6-7:30pm

Confirmation Preparation is the beginning of the journey to receive the graces of this sacrament and enter more deeply into the spiritual life of the Church. Preparation is 2 years for this important sacrament, beginning no earlier than 9th grade. During the twice monthly classes youth will learn about the faith through speakers, discussion, prayer, and the Bible.

- **Small Groups:** The youth will have an opportunity to grow in their faith with other teens in the program.
- **Discipleship Conferences:** One on one mentoring, provided on a monthly basis will help the youth to progress through the program and actually live as a follower of Jesus.
- **Parent Sessions:** Parents play an important role in passing on the faith to their children. Parents will join us 5 times during the year to learn how to support their child's preparation for confirmation. Session will be offered in both English and Spanish.
- **Mass:** Sunday mass is our opportunity to worship God and received his sacrifice for us. It is vitally important youth attend mass every week.
- **Service:** Service to others has always been an important part of the Christian life. Youth will have the opportunity to serve in both our parish and the community.
- **Retreat:** The retreat offers a unique experience to step away from the busyness of life and encounter Christ. Net Ministries will lead our retreat. Net is staffed by young Catholics 18-28 who have given a year to serve the Church through leading retreats. **March 20-21**
