



Easter Message for 2020

The Lord is Risen from the dead and has appeared to Mary Magdalene and the Apostles. On Easter Sunday morning we hear the Gospel of St. John which states: "They have taken the Lord from the tomb and we do not know where they have put him?" These are the words of Mary Magdala as she discovers the empty tomb. We like Mary Magdala are wondering where is the Lord with no Mass, no community of believers to gather, sheltering in place and being afraid of what may happen to us? Peter and John run to the tomb to investigate. Peter enters and sees the burial cloth but does not understand what this means. John, the beloved disciple, saw and believed. Where are you this Easter with Mary Magdala, Peter or John? Confronted with the empty tomb or an empty church what does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus at this time and place.

May we read the accounts of the Resurrection and the Acts on the Apostles to hear anew this message of hope and inspiration. Death has not won but Christ has been victorious. Love has conquered sin and death. We will celebrate the Ascension in 40 days as the Lord goes to reign from Heaven and we celebrate Pentecost in 50 days where the Holy Spirit is sent to connect us directly with the love of God and to join the mission to proclaim it to the ends of the Earth. Jesus Christ Reigns in heaven and earth! The door to heaven has been opened to us.

I believe and while there has been tears for the suffering, sickness, isolation, and lack of a physical group of believers, I will say my faith is alive and the Lord is close. It is a crisis like this where we have "a come to Jesus talk" about life and what is it about? My prayer has been for you my community and my family. I asked the Lord to keep me healthy not for me but so I may serve the people of God. I believe I was created for this time to give a witness of faith in God who is alive and ready to meet us where we are to bring us life and hope.

As we continue to shelter in place let us connect with the Lord in prayer. It is that still small voice which the Lord usually uses in quiet prayer where God reveals his presence and mission for each of us. Please pray for those who are ill, have lost their job or are alone.

Our Office can receive messages but calls will be returned on Tuesday and Thursday during Easter week.

We depend on donations. Please sign up for Online Giving on our website at www.olgcv.org, mail in your contribution, or drop it in our office mail slot. We have also installed a Donation Box in the church which is by the front pew and is collected daily.

We are looking into Flocknotes as another reliable way to communicate to our parishioners. If you would like to be added to our contact list and receive a note once a week, please email us your email address to newsletter@olgcv.org.

My mission as your pastor is to connect you to Jesus and the Sacraments so you can be saved and get to heaven. Fr. Paul Fazio and Fr. Thomas Hamilton are in self quarantine due to their vulnerability. They both offer a daily Mass in private. Fr. Paul prays for the Our Lady of Grace Community and Fr. Thomas prays for the friars and those who support us. Fr. Francisco Nahoe continues to direct our Youth Confirmation Program and is in contact with those preparing for Confirmation.

During the Easter season I will be bringing Holy Communion home delivery style for our seniors and others who want to receive and must stay home. You can have the Easter Communion delivered during the Easter Season. The Eucharist delivered will not be touched by human hands. The host will be in a sterilized pyx and placed in a plastic bag and delivered in a brown paper bag. Fr. Tom would like to visit even if we need to meet in your front yard during the Easter Season. Fr. Tom also offers anointing of the sick because he will not be allowed to perform the anointing at the hospital. Be assured that the anointing procedure will be performed without any touching. Please call the Parish Office at 510-537-0806 and leave your telephone number so we can schedule a Eucharist delivery and visit.

CHURCH SCHEDULE UPDATE

In response to the Alameda County Health Department's legal order directing residents to shelter in place, Our Lady of Grace Office will be closed to the public until further notice.

Our Lady of Grace Church will be open daily from 10:15 AM to 7:00 PM for private prayer. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on Sundays from 10:15 AM to 7:00 PM. On Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 5:00-7:00 PM, the Blessed Sacrament will also be exposed and Confessions will be heard. Please observe social distancing of 6 feet between others. It is recommended that no more than 10 people gather in the church at one time. Please use the disinfectant wipes provided to clean your area before and after your time in the church.

Eucharist will be offered on Sundays at the hours of 8AM, 11AM and 1PM in the Gathering Area. Please maintain social distancing during at those times. Continue to check the website (www.olgcv.org) for the most current information.



THE 2020 BISHOP'S APPEAL



SUGGESTIONS FOR HOW TO CELEBRATE A LIVESTREAMED MASS

Remember you are in the loving presence of the Lord. As you gather in your home to participate at the online Mass consider these suggestions:

- Gather the family and set up an altar or prayer space with a crucifix and candle
- Wear your Sunday Mass attire and do not have any food, drink or electronic devices to distract you from being present and consciously participating at Mass.
- Recite the corresponding responses and observe the proper gestures at Mass, like standing, sitting and kneeling.
- At Communion time, prayerfully recite the *Prayer of Spiritual Communion*: "My Jesus, I believe that you suffered and died, and rose from death to save us. I believe that you are fully present in the bread this is blessed and broken, and the wine that is blessed and poured out in the sacrament of the Eucharist/ Renew in me your sacrificial presence, and let me be united with you at this moment, so that, in all my thoughts, words and actions, I may represent you, and love others as you love me. Amen"

as sign of our safety and hope.


We entrust ourselves to you,
