October Is The Month of Mary

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. Mary praised St. Dominic for his valiant fight against the heretical teachings and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon, explained its uses and efficacy, and told him to preach it to others. "Since the prayers of the Rosary come from such excellent sources — from Our Lord Himself, from inspired Scripture, and from the Church — it is not surprising that the Rosary is so dear to our Blessed Mother and so powerful with heaven. "If we consider the power of the Rosary as seen in its effects, we find a great abundance of proofs of its wonderful value. Many are the favors granted to private individuals through its devout recitation: there are few devoted users of the Rosary who cannot testify to experiencing its power in their own lives. If we turn to history, we see many great triumphs of the Rosary. St. Pius V attributed the great victory at Lepanto on the first Sunday of October, 1571, to the fact that at the same time the Rosary confraternities at Rome and elsewhere were holding their processions. Accordingly, he ordered a commemoration of the Rosary to be made on that day. Today, there are dangers to Christianity and all civilizations. We are urged by our Blessed Mother to turn again to the Rosary for help. Please join us for the Rosary 30 minutes before each Mass to pray.
