Half of all proceeds remain in our diocese and support local needs, so please be generous in this collection.

WELCOMING REFUGEES AT OLG

In Matthew (Mt25:35), we are encouraged to love and care for the stranger. "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me". Our Savior himself lived as a refugee because his own land was not safe. In January, Bishop Michael Barber asked, "Wouldn't it be great if we became the first diocese in the USA where every parish co-sponsored a refugee family with Catholic Charities?" In March, several of your fellow parishioners met and asked, "Wouldn't it be great if we could be one of the parishes to respond to this call for service?" Answer: We hope to be!

On May 14th and 15th you will be hearing more about our proposal at the Masses. There will also be an important planning meeting on Wednesday, May 18th at 7:00pm at which you can get answers to your questions and find out the ways you can participate.

For example, there will be opportunities to provide a warm welcome at the airport, collect household goods and furnishings, stock the pantry, and/or connect refugees to available services. It is important to remember that we will be working in partnership with the Catholic Charities East Bay's Refugee Resettlement Program, rather than taking on this challenge on our own. It is also our hope that we will be working in partnership with a sizeable group of committed parishioners so that the work of providing support to the newly arrived refugee family will be a shared responsibility and a joy to perform.
