- 2. Preference for Holy Communion on the hand. Those who choose to receive on the tongue, please receive last.
- 3. During the Our Father, do not hold hands.
- 4. During the sign of peace, offer a head bow and not a hand shake.

Thanks to all for following the precautions. Does one receive the whole Christ if one receives only Holy Communion? Yes. Christ Jesus, our Lord and Savior, is wholly present under the appearance either of bread or of wine in the Eucharist. Furthermore, Christ is wholly present in any fragment of the consecrated Host or in any drop of the Precious Blood (cf. Eucharisticum Mysterium, no. 32).

## PRESIDENTS DAY **PARISH HOLIDAY**




