Mary, The Mother of God

On Friday, we celebrate Mary, the Mother of God (Theotokos). This was the first defined Dogma about Mary at the Council of Ephesus in 431. Being a Dogma, it is essential we believe that Mary was the Theotokos (God birther or bearer). Jesus was truly human who was born in Bethlehem and his Mother was Mary. This seems obvious to us today yet the questions of the identity of Jesus and His origin is questioned by many even to this day. There are those who deny he even existed or if he did exist he was just human and a failed revolutionary. This teaching about Mary as the Theotokos is essential for us to understand who Jesus is and what he offers humanity. If we do not understand who Jesus is and that he is human and divine, then we can never find the way to salvation. Mary is the key that opens humanity to salvation and grace. Her "yes" in the Annunciation opened the way for our God and Savior, changing the destiny of humanity from fallen to redeemed. The battle continues to this day. Will we live our lives in our fallen nature that leads to death or will we accept redemption in Jesus Christ and inherit Eternal Life?

## **Epiphany (January 3rd) God Made Manifest**

The Epiphany of Our Lord is the Christian feast observed traditionally on January 6th, transferred to January 3rd in our diocese this year. The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek *epiphainen*, a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." Thus, the feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made Himself known to the world, mainly the three events that manifested the mission and divinity of Christ: the visit of the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12), the baptism of Jesus (Mark 1:9-11), and the miracle at Cana (John 2:1-11). The visit of the Magi is emphasized on Epiphany Day, and Christ's baptism is celebrated the first Sunday that follows.

Let us join the Magi to come and adore our Lord and King. Come to Bethlehem with the Magi as they follow the star leading them to discover God made manifest in the Word, made flesh in the child Jesus. We honor Mary His Mother and Joseph His protector. Come to the manger and adore.

I remember the celebration of the Epiphany in 2016 in Rome as we celebrated a High Mass at St. Peter's with Pope Francis with choirs from around the world. We then left the liturgy to encounter a procession recognizing the acceptance of Christianity through history and in Italy. When did your family and heritage discover Jesus made manifest? Who shared Jesus with you?




