Next weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Pope Francis told Christians worldwide last year, "We cannot do without the Eucharist, for it is God's memorial. And it heals our wounded memory." I witnessed this healing power myself as I saw people in tears coming to receive the Eucharist at the door of the Church and at our outdoor Masses this last year. When Mass was restricted, we all hungered for Jesus and the gathering of the community of faith for the breaking of the bread. In this world the presence of Jesus is essential to healing and strengthening us.

We are blessed to be celebrating First Communion on Saturday, **June 5th** at 11AM and Confirmation on Sunday, **June 6th** at 11AM. We are blessed to have a large Confirmation Class and to have Fr. Lawrence D'Anjou, Vicar General of the Diocese, to officiate at the Mass. **If you regularly attend the Sunday 11AM Mass, please choose another Mass to attend since seating will be very limited due to the Confirmation.** The Saturday 11AM Mass has plenty of space and is the Sunday Liturgy as an alternate option.

Amen.*





Gospel for The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (June 6th)

Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?" He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, 'The Teacher says, "Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?"' Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them; and they prepared the Passover. While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.
