In 1917, Mother Mary appeared to three young children with a message of peace for our world. The three children were able to hear the message of the Blessed Mother, and they shared her message with all who would listen. I invite you to do a little research on Fatima. We are still invited to pray for peace in our world.

Francisco and Jacinta both contracted the Spanish Flu in 1918. Francisco died in 1919 and Jacinta in 1920. Both children offered their sufferings for sinners and looked forward to being with Our Lady in heaven. When the time came for Francisco to leave, the little girl told him: "Give my greetings to Our Lord and to Our Lady and tell them that I am enduring everything they want for the conversion of sinners". John Paul II said: "two candles which God lit to illumine humanity in its dark and anxious hours." And it is in the acceptance of her (Jacinta) sufferings and death that she is such a wonderful example for all of us. Jacinta willingly accepted her suffering when it was foretold to her by the Blessed Mother and offered it for the conversion of sinners. May we learn from the children of Fatima during our pandemic to trust in the love of God and the intercession of the Blessed Mother whom the children hoped. St. Francisco and St. Jacinta, pray for us. Their example in suffering saved the souls of many. May we offer our sufferings for the conversion of souls to know the love of God in this world and the world to come. I invite all children to pray a Rosary for your mother today.

I would like to wish all mothers a very Happy Mother's Day. Thank you for all the sacrifices you have made for us. Thank you for the gift of life. Today as we gather as a community of Faith, we gather with Mother Church to receive all she has to share with us. My prayer for our parish is that we recognize the maternal gifts of the Church. The Church is meant to be a place for healing and for nurturing our God-given gifts. It is a place where we can grow in freedom to become true servants of God. I encourage you to seek the freedom that God desires for you, then seek ways to serve and to encourage others.

My Mother and Grandmothers have been examples of faith which have nurtured me and strengthened my faith. I am so grateful for their love and which has given me life and faith. I feel blessed by the many Mothers, Grandmothers, and Godmothers who have changed our parish and our world through Love. May God Bless you today and for all eternity.


