Join us next weekend to celebrate Father's Day on June 20th. We will have blessings and gifts to thank our fathers. Active fathers in family and faith have a profound influence on the practice of the faith in their children. **3. Make a Love of the Father Video / Photo Montage**




**WORSHIP AIDS**


