Thursday - November 4th

O Lord God, by the Precious Blood of Your divine Son, Jesus, which was shed in His bitter crowning with thorns, deliver the souls in Purgatory, and among them those souls who are in greatest need of our prayers, in order that they may not long be delayed in praising you fully in Your glory and blessing you forever. Amen. Our Father . . ., Hail, Mary . . ., Eternal rest give to them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them.

Friday- November 5th


