The Friars will pray for Our Lady of Grace community and offer Mass intentions from May 31st to June 3rd, Tuesday - Friday, as we gather in Chapter. At OLG, there will be Word and Communion Services on those days. There will be no Adoration and Confession on Thursday, June 2nd.

Meditation


