**‘Thank You’ Reception For Fr. Tom**

The Parish Pastoral Counsel along with several of the parish ministries are hosting a ‘Thank You’ reception for Fr. Tom on Wednesday, **June 29th** at 6:30pm in Stack Center. All parishioners and their families are invited to come say ‘Thank You’ to Fr. Tom for the many Spiritual and Temporal benefits he has brought to Our Lady of Grace Parish during his 7 years as Pastor. Here is just a short list of the many benefits Fr. Tom has added to the community:

Return of the Tabernacle to the center of the church, return of Our Lady of Grace statue to the right of Christ, return of St. Joseph's statue (given by the Holy Family Friary) to the church and at the left of Christ as a member of the Holy Family, a complete remodeling of the Church under budget and ahead of schedule, implementation of Whole Family Catechesis greatly improving religious education at the Parish, remodeling of Stack Center, installation of solar panels to lower electrical expenses for the campus. Also, Fr. Tom ensured Our Lady of Grace stayed open daily for prayer and veneration and the faithful had access to the Sacraments and Mass when most churches were closed during the pandemic with outdoor Communion and Confession, Masses in the parking lot, Masses in the School Courtyard, Masses in the new outdoor St. Francis Garden Chapel and Masses in Stack Center. Construction of the new outdoor Chapel has been used for outdoor Masses and weddings and will continue to be used during the Fall Festival and other events going forward. Additionally, Fr. Tom initiated the construction of the Shrine for the Unborn, the chartering of the Knights of Columbus Council and Columbiettes Auxiliary at the Parish, starting the MI Village at OLG resulting in hundreds of consecrations to the Blessed Mother, the addition of a second Confessional and staffing of the Confessionals with 2 Priests each Saturday, the weddings and quinceañeras that have blessed the community, the celebration of traditional Catholic practices such as processions, veneration of Saints, and Fr. Tom's love for the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Sacred Heart of Our Lady, St. Michael, Divine Mercy, Novena's all during the year, institution of the Latin Mass, Fr. Tom's ability to listen to the younger members of the community, involve the young in the community activities, the time he took to join them at meals and the many times he cooked for the youth groups. Continued support of Birthright of San Lorenzo and 40 Days For Life to help save lives, construction of the new and permanent home for the Shrine for Our Lady of Guadalupe, and the many fun community events over the years.

**Gospel For The Fourteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time (July 3rd)**

**Luke 10:1-12, 17-20**

At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you. Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another. Whatever town you enter, and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.' Whatever town you enter and they do not receive you, go out into the streets and say, 'The dust of your town that clings to our feet, even that we shake off against you.' Yet know this: the kingdom of God is at hand. I tell you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom on that day than for that town." The seventy-two returned rejoicing, and said, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name." Jesus said, "I have observed Satan fall like lightning from the sky. Behold, I have given you the power to 'tread upon serpents' and scorpions and upon the full force of the enemy and nothing will harm you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven."





**OLG'S 75TH ANNIVERSARY  
A Memory of Our History**

When Rev. James Keane served as pastor from 1972 through June 1980, new parish groups began. School parents participated in a School Board and they resumed Bingo. In 1979, the Carmelite Sisters left the school for other duties. They are remembered with affection. Visitors of the Sick was organized to minister to those in the hospitals and convalescent homes. The Italian Catholic Federation began in the parish. The First Friday Club was started with people meeting for Mass and lunch on the 1st Fridays to plan social functions, bus trips and fundraising activities. In 1982, this group purchased the statue of Our Lady for the inside of the church.
