Happy Lent!! How is your Journey this Lent? This is your opportunity to grow in your Christian life and grow in holiness. Remember the three pillars of Lent: Fasting, From the Paster Prayer and Alms Giving.

Fasting – There are many ways to Fast. The traditional form is Food. Please think wider than this. How about fasting from anger, fasting from the internet, fasting from the phone, fasting from games, fasting from TV or fasting from alcohol or tobacco. What is interfering with you having time for the Lord or for the people you live with. Allow your fasting to truly affect your relationships in your family, work and Church.

Prayer – There are many ways to pray, in Church, at home, while you are exercising, going for a walk etc.. Some use prayers, rosary, prayer books or reflection and mediation. Do you take some quality time to pray each day? Are you giving God a chance to work with you and his grace?

Alms Giving – There are so many opportunities to give alms each day. When we give alms, we are giving a sign to others of the value of human life and a true sign of God's Hope. Alms are a vehicle of God's grace. Possible Lenten Alms are giving to the poor, the Bishop Appeal, our parish, the Missions or our local OLG School. Please be responsible in giving alms. Make certain you are not giving to a scam.

Two important Fundraising events are scheduled: the School Fun Run on March 23rd and the Spring Auction on May 6th. The School Fun Run supports our School and the Auction supports both our Parish and School. Thank you for all the support that you can give to both these events.



FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

If you have an IRA and are over the age of 70 1/2, you are faced with a required minimum distribution from your IRA. The IRS has a qualified charitable donation rule that allows you to exempt your distribution from taxes. The significant advantage of this is that it lowers your adjusted gross income. The main rules are: donation must be paid directly from the IRA to the charity; the donor must be over $70\frac{1}{2}$; the amount is limited to \$100k. If you are in this situation, check and see if it makes sense for you to apply this IRS rule and direct your distribution to Our Lady of Grace Parish. *May God Bless your generous giving*.


