This is because the Resurrection of Jesus is the basis of our faith. As Saint Paul wrote in his first letter to the Corinthians: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain, and

your faith is in vain." There would be no Christianity and the Church would not exist if Jesus had not risen from the dead.

I pray that all of you have made a good Lent, preparing your heart, mind, and soul for this great Feast. Celebrate it in your heart, celebrate with your family. Please use it as an opportunity for your family to be together. Talk with one another, eat with one another, be together and pray together. Many a family gets so busy, or some get lost in Computer games, Facetime or like sites where no real relationships are grown. Use Easter and the Easter Season to celebrate life, new-life in the Risen Lord. May we find new life in ourselves, one another, in family and here at Church.
