Everyone wants the faithful, retired priests cared for. Everyone wants our Church to grow through Religious Education and Faith Formation. Everything costs. Remember as you give, please know that 100% of this money will go only to these dedicated works of the Diocese. This money is restricted by law. Anything over and beyond our goal in this Appeal will be returned to our parish for our use.

I also want to thank you for your continued generosity to our parish. I believe that God will see us through as our money is tight. We have been hit with unexpected bills, such as our heating bills, but that is not news to you. God will see us through! If you are a weekly contributor, please don't forget the parish when you are away. If you can see yourself giving just a little more each week, thank you. If you could make a special contribution to the parish, such as for utilities (heating), thank you.

Just one more reminder. The planning for our Parish Festival has begun. Volunteer where you can. This will be our first real Festival since Covid. A Festival is gathering of our parish community, as well as many of our neighbors. It is also our major fundraiser for our Parish and School. Our OLG School is the largest ministry of our parish. Last weekend, we celebrated First Communion in our parish. The week before, we celebrated Confirmation. Our OLG School just held Graduation for our 8th grade. Congratulations to our graduates and their families. This week is the last week of school for the rest of our OLG students. Then the school will begin summer school.

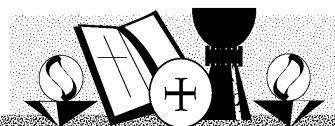


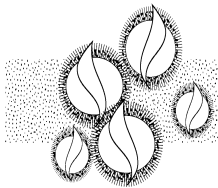

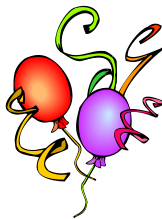


OLG EVANGELIZATION COORDINATOR JOB POSTING

Our Lady of Grace Parish is seeking a Coordinator to manage the K-5 Whole Family Programs. The Coordinator is responsible for developing curriculum consistent with the Diocesan guidelines. 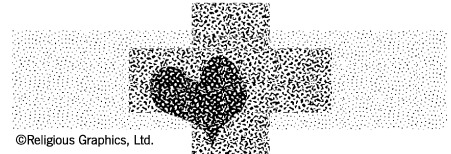
