ICF DINNER & MEETING June 8th

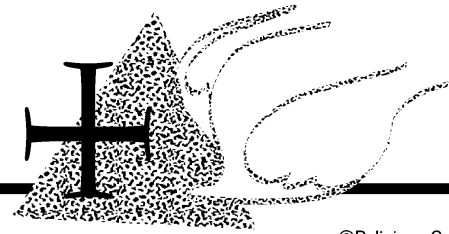

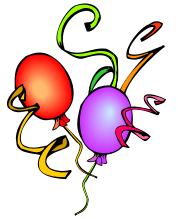

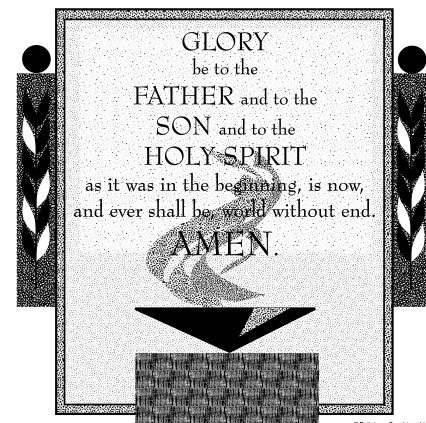
