

Dear Friends in Christ,

In our own prayer lives, we have the opportunity to hear God speaking to us, to be attentive to the will of God and be willing to carry out God's will.

"Let it be done to me according to thy Word" are the words spoken by Mary at the Annunciation which expressed her willingness to carry out God's will. At that moment, Mary became an instrument of God's Grace. Mary was prepared "by the overshadowing of the Holy Spirit" to be the mother of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Being conceived immaculately, Mary was that worthy tabernacle for the Lord in His coming to birth and as she pondered in her heart everything that took place in Jesus' life. Then, after falling asleep in the Lord, Mary was assumed into heaven. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated this week Tuesday, August 15th. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. On Holy Days of Obligation, we are required to attend Mass. Masses here at Our Lady of Grace Church are at 8:15am and 7:00pm. We look forward to seeing you on this special day in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

August 14th is the Feast Day of St. Maximilian Kolbe. Through The Militia of the Immaculate which St. Maximilian established, he encouraged consecration to Mary as a means of spiritual renewal. Enrollment in the Militia of the Immaculate (The MI) takes place through today. St. Maximilian was arrested and placed in the concentration camp at Auschwitz where he died. He offered his life in place of another prisoner, Franciszek Gajowniczek. After his release, the rest of Franciszek Gajowniczek's life was spent promoting devotion to St. Maximilian Kolbe. Today, Franciszek Gajowniczek is buried in the cemetery at Niepokalanow (City of the Immaculate), Poland.

Visiting Auschwitz and the cell where St. Maximilian died continues to be a most stirring experience. In the quiet of that place, you sense the atrocities that took place there as well as the strong faith of St. Maximilian Kolbe and so many more who died there.

Celebrating the Feast of St. Maximilian Kolbe and the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin, consider enrolling in the Militia of the Immaculate. A Meeting of The Militia takes place here at Our Lady of Grace Church on the First Saturday of the Month. 
RAFFLE TICKETS

NOTICE OF BAR DATE FILING BY RCBO

The Roman Catholic Bishop of Oakland ("RCBO") is pleased that the court has set a definitive deadline of **September 11, 2023**, for survivors of sexual abuse to file claims in RCBO's Chapter 11 case. This deadline, known as a "Bar Date," is the date set for all claims to be filed in the Chapter 11 case. To ensure potential claimants are aware of the Bar Date, the Court has <u>ordered</u> RCBO to post the Notice of Deadline for Filing Sexual Abuse Claims on its digital and physical properties in all its churches, schools, and social media accounts. These notices are posted at the bulletin boards located in the church and available in the Parish Office.
