

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ.

Each year, we celebrate a Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. It is celebrated from January 18th to January 25th. The theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity in 2024 is "You shall love the Lord your God... and your neighbor as yourself" taken from the Gospel of St. Luke, Chapter 10, verse 27.

The lengthier passage from the Gospel of St. Luke (10:25-37) tells the story of how Jesus is asked by a lawyer, "What must I do to inherit everlasting life?" and Jesus responds, "What is written in the law? What do you read there?" The lawyer responds, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." Then Jesus says to him, "You have given the right answer; do this, and you will live." But then in order to justify himself, the lawyer says, "And who is my neighbor?" which leads Jesus to tell the parable of the Good Samaritan.

I am sure that we are all familiar with the story of the Good Samaritan. It offers us the opportunity to reflect on who is our neighbor. We need to ask ourselves who is our neighbor in light of the Story of the Good Samaritan. Each person is brother and sister and mother to us. Each person is neighbor to us. What this week is offering us is an invitation to imitate the love of God by giving of ourselves. Reaching out to others binds us together. There is a unity created between and among us.

Let's pray for Christian Unity. I suggest to offer this prayer for Christian Unity this week: We pray, O Gracious Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, that we all may be one as you are one. In your community of complete unity, we have our beginning and our end. To You, we pray, asking for the gift of visible unity among all who believe in your Christ.

Then they came to Capernaum, and on the sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes. In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit; he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" Jesus rebuked him and said, "Quiet! Come out of him!" The unclean spirit convulsed him and with a loud cry came out of him. All were amazed and asked one another, "What is this? COFFEE AND DONUTS January 21st


Come join us! All are invited after the 9:00am Sunday Mass to meet in the Gathering Area outside the rear entrance of the church for coffee, donuts and community.


