

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday is Laetare Sunday. It calls to mind that we are at the halfway point through Lent. Drawing closer to the Celebration of Easter, Laetare Sunday offers us the opportunity to check how we are doing with our fasting, our doing penance and our giving alms.

Having considered prayer and almsgiving, it would be beneficial for us to reflect on how our fasting prepares us for Easter. Thinking about the many opportunities for us to fast, we should be making the effort to make our fasting meaningful. Whatever our fasting entails, let's pray that what we have done so far in this Lenten Season and what we will do will unite us with and bring us closer to Our Lord.

My friends, fasting needs to be a form of sacrifice. We intentionally ought to deprive ourselves of something and offer up that inconvenience in union with Christ's suffering on the cross. In a very real sense, we should be removing something from our lives in order to make more space for Christ. The real purpose of fasting then is so that we can spend more time with Jesus. We have to make a conscious effort to replace the things we are fasting from with something that will help us grow in our relationship with Jesus. Along with Lenten fasting that we are all called to do, even though many promise to give up chocolates or junk food and the like throughout these 40 days, we need to have the right frame of mind. How is our fasting bringing us closer to Christ? Along with the familiar forms of fasting, we also can try and do something a little different. Maybe some are doing this style of fasting but, with a few weeks left before the Celebration of the Resurrection, maybe others would like to develop a new style of fasting. Whatever you have done up to now and what you will do for the rest of Lent, needs to have a purpose and that purpose is to grow closer in relationship with Christ.

#### Here are just a few ideas:

- .....getting up 15 minutes earlier to pray
- ....read the daily Mass Readings
- ....sit in silence for 10 minutes a day
- .....make an examination of conscience each evening
- ....affirm others
- ....reading a spiritual book for 15 minutes

These are just a few ideas. There are so many more that we can do on our faith journey. In all these, let's focus on the Lord who has suffered and died for us and is risen for us and for our salvation. Celebrating Laetare Sunday, through the remainder of this Lenten Season, may the Lenten Practices we incorporate into our daily activities, draw us closer to Jesus.

#### The Fifth Sunday of Lent (March 17th)

John 12:20-33

Some Greeks who had come to worship at the Passover Feast came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus. Jesus answered them, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Amen, amen, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit. Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will preserve it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there also will my servant be. The Father will honor whoever serves me. "I am troubled now. Yet what should I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name." Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again." The crowd there heard it and said it was thunder; but others said, "An angel has spoken to him." Jesus answered and said, "This voice did not come for my sake but for yours. Now is the time of judgment on this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself." He said this indicating the kind of death he would die.



#### FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

If you have an IRA and are over the age of 70 1/2, you are faced with a required minimum distribution from your IRA. The IRS has a qualified charitable donation rule that allows you to exempt your distribution from taxes. The significant advantage of this is that it lowers your adjusted gross income. The main rules are: donation must be paid directly from the IRA to the charity; the donor must be over 70½; the amount is limited to \$100k. If you are in this situation, check and see if it makes sense for you to apply this IRS rule and direct your distribution to Our Lady of Grace Parish. May God Bless your generous giving.
