HOLY HOUR FOR DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Sunday, April 7, 2024



Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord,

Today, the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday. It was five days after the Canonization of St. Faustina, May 5, 2000, that the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter, this Sunday, be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Repeatedly, The Lord requested of St. Faustina that a Feast of Mercy, Divine Mercy Sunday, be observed. On 14 occasions the Lord requested of St. Faustina: My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a

whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me. ... It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.

Celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday, this afternoon at 3:00 PM at Our Lady of Grace Church, a Holy Hour for Divine Mercy will be taking place. Everyone is invited to attend. Fr. Raphael

Third Sunday of Easter (April 14th)

Luke 24:35-48

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread. While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then he said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." And as he said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of baked fish; he took it and ate it in front of them. He said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."
