
The holy rosary is always a wonderful prayer to enter more deeply into the mysteries of Christ's life with Mary. It is a Gospel prayer.

May the patroness of the Diocese of Oakland, Our Lady, Queen of the World, help us draw ever closer to Christ her Son!



Mark 16:15-20






