

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

As we celebrate Independence Day, the 4th of July this week, we can call to mind the words of the Preamble to the Declaration of Independence: we hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable

rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness. As our country celebrates Independence Day on July 4th, we, baptized into the family of God, the Church, can celebrate the 4th of July with the acknowledgement that it is in and through the Celebration of Baptism that we are marked with the indelible sign of the sacrament, a sign that cannot be erased. Inalienable rights are rights that cannot be taken away.

This week we celebrate that which took place on July 4, 1776. We celebrate the fact that this great nation was established. As we celebrate our citizenship in this nation, through Baptism, we celebrate each of us being incorporated into Christ and His Church. In renouncing sin and making a profession of faith, we proclaim that this is our faith. It is the faith of the Church and we ought to be proud in professing our faith with one another, in Christ Jesus the Lord. On July 4th, we hear the National Anthem being sung with such enthusiasm. As members of the Church, we have the Profession of Faith. This Profession of Faith, I believe in one God...., needs to be recited wholeheartedly. It needs to be given expression in our daily lives so that being baptized into new life in Christ Jesus, we are immersed into the Paschal Mystery, the life, death, and resurrection of the Lord. Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness are the inalienable rights spoken of in the Preamble to the Declaration of Independence. Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness are ours in our Life in Christ Jesus as members of Christ's Family, the Church. We are given new life in Christ. We are given freedom, no longer living in the darkness of sin but walking in the light of the Lord. The pursuit of happiness is ours, sharing in the good things of the Lord every day of our lives and looking forward to one day being with the Lord in heaven.

This is our true happiness. We are citizens of heaven. Baptism is the public declaration of our faith and our rebirth in Christ Jesus, the Lord. This Sacrament binds us together as members of God's Family, the Church. The Pledge of Allegiance, I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America...... is our civic declaration of our connectedness to one another and to this nation.

Enjoy the 4th of July! Celebrate our independence under God, indivisible! Celebrate Baptism!

He gets enough in Social Security to make it through the month but not enough for any extras—like furniture. 


