

The Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time (February 16th)


Luke 6:17, 20-26


Attention Ladies! Are you interested in becoming active in our parish? Come see what the Columbiettes are all about. We meet on the 3rd Wednesday of each month.



Brothers and Sisters! I want to thank all who gave me a thought and a prayer when my name appeared on the Prayer List a few weeks ago. A lot of people have asked what was going on, and it's a simple answer: Over a year ago I was diagnosed with Atrial Fibrillation, wherein the heart's upper chamber inexplicably starts beating irregularly and rapidly. My cardiologist told me I could be "proactive" and do something about it, via a procedure called "cardioversion." I decided to do so, and felt prayers would help me across the month of preparation for the procedure, during which, while under sedation, electrical stimulus is applied to the heart in hopes it will "reset" to its normal rhythms. This safe procedure did indeed reset my heart! The energy of Prayer Power is a beautiful thing, as is the infinite mercy and love of our Almighty Father in Heaven. AMEN!
