Thank You for being present at Mass this Sunday and every Sunday. Your presence is so important for the vitality of our faith.

And, my friends, as we celebrate the Ascension this Sunday we look forward to the Celebration of Pentecost which is celebrated 50 days after The Resurrection of Our Lord (Easter). This will mark the end of the Easter Season. Anticipating the end of the Easter Season, thank you for your presence throughout the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday/Good Friday/Holy Saturday/Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday) and the involvement of so many who prepared, decorated and served in the various liturgical ministries so important for full and active participation in the life of Our Lady of Grace, our Church.


