

Mission Statement

My Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Coming together for the Celebration of the Eucharist is of utmost importance for us because the Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian Life. With this in mind, our active participation when we come together for Mass that is important.

Our Faith Community offers many opportunities to be active participants. Have you considered being a greeter or usher, an altar server, a lector or special minister of the Eucharist, or a member of our music ministry? Would you be willing to be a catechist at the Liturgy of the Word for Children? Let the Parish Office (510-537-0806) know if you are interested.

Greeters and Ushers are the first members of the Parish Family we meet as we enter our Church for Mass. Each Mass needs several greeters and ushers to cheerfully welcome the members of our community, our extended family members and guests coming to celebrate the Eucharist. Greeters and ushers just need to come early on the day they are assigned, greet everyone as we enter, hand out bulletins and ask a family to offer the gifts of bread and wine for Mass.

Altar Servers assist the celebrant with his responsibilities at Mass. They are cross-bearers and candle-bearers. They assist by holding the Roman Missal (The Altar Book) for the celebrant of the Mass, the pouring of the water and the wine, the washing of the hands, and the preparation of the altar. Participating as an altar server is a very meaningful way to participate at Mass.

Lectors proclaim the Word of God. As a lector, you proclaim the Word of God, the Scripture Readings for the day, offers the petitions included in the Prayer of the Faithful. A number of lectors at each Mass would be wonderful. As a Special Minister of the Eucharist you would offer the Body and Blood of Christ to those receiving the Eucharist. Special Ministers of the Eucharist also can take the Eucharist to the homebound as needed.

Music enhances The Celebration of the Eucharist. Each voice adds a richness to the music offered. There are beautiful voices heard throughout the Church. Keep singing beautifully as a member of the choir. Playing an instrument can also enrich a choral setting. Join the choir. Become a cantor. Assist in leading the congregation in song.

Hospitality is essential as we enter Church for the Celebration of the Mass and after our Mass(es). Preparing and offering coffee, juice, donuts and maybe even a little more after Mass adds to our ties of friendship and community, the community we have right here at our Church.

Be involved. Be Church with and for one another.




