

From the Pastor


My Sisters and Brothers in the Lord,

Both here at Our Lady of Grace Church as well as at Transfiguration Church we celebrated the Solemnity of St. Francis of Assisi on October 4th. We had the Blessing of Animals here at Our Lady of Grace on October 4th, and at Transfiguration on October 5th. The Transitus, a Service commemorating The Passing of St. Francis into Eternity, took place here at Our Lady of Grace this year on October 3rd, the day before the Solemnity of St. Francis of Assisi. The morning of October 3rd, the students at Our Lady of Grace School brought their pets to have them blessed before the start of the School Day.

The Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time (October 26th)

Luke18:9-14

Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else. "Two people went up to the temple area to pray; one was a Pharisee and the other was a tax collector. The Pharisee took up his position and spoke this prayer to himself, 'O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity -- greedy, dishonest, adulterous -- or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, and I pay tithes on my whole income.' But the tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."


SVdP'S ANNUAL FALL BINGO FUNDRAISER October 25th Transfiguration Church


