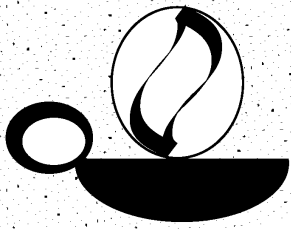


**The Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time (February 1st)**

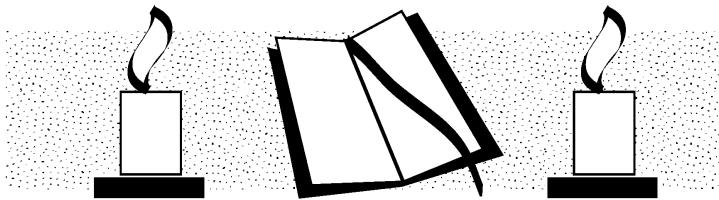
