Four Pillars of Faith Formation at OLG:

- 1) **Parent Educators:** As the parents you play the most important role in passing on the faith to your children. For this reason, both children and parents attend classes together.
- 2) **Prayer:** Prayer is the key to worshiping God and loving Jesus. We make prayer part of the rhythm of our lives. We draw from traditional memorized prayers as well as creative prayer experience to help us encounter God in a deeper way.
- 3) **Sunday Mass:** As Christians we gather on Sunday to worship God and offer the sacrifice of the mass. It is vitally important that Christian families find time for Sunday worship.
- 4) **Catechesis:** The goal of catechesis is to teach your children the fullness of the Catholic faith so that they can know who God is, trust in Jesus' saving work and love God with their whole heart. We want to give your children the tools to live a happy and moral life that will one day help them to arrive in heaven.
